

## Oral Presentation Grading

I am really excited to hear your oral presentations. I hope that you put a lot of effort and thought into your projects. I am grading you a majority of your project but I am also letting you grade a small portion of your presentation as well. You know how hard you worked on your presentation. There are some teachers in America who ask students to complete self-assessments. The theory behind self-assessments is to give students a chance to reflect honestly on their work and to develop trust between the teacher and the student. I hope you take the self-assessment seriously and reflect on your presentation when you complete the assessment.

Here are the four areas you will rate yourself on with a score out of five.

- Were you ready?
- I did honest and good research.
- I presented the topic well.
- I did a good job.

Your self-assessment score will be 20 points out of the 100 for the oral presentation.

I will grade based on the following areas.

- **Information** – What did you present? Was the information correct? *(25 points)*
- **Presentation** – Did you speak clearly? Did you have handouts or presentation guides? Did you have the proper presentation stature? *(25 points)*
- **Organization and Wording** – Was the presentation organized? Did you use proper English grammar? Did your speech flow well? *(25 points)*
- **Answering Questions** – Were you able to answer the questions effectively? *(5 points)*

The number of points I award for your presentation is 80 points out of 100.
