The TNPU English Forum was created by PCRV Sharece M Bunn as a way to gather English speakers in Ternopil together for a chance to speak with native speakers who are volunteering in the oblast.

The forum will be in a large classroom, ideally with moveable tables and chairs to make the small groups easier to work with.
