## TNPU English Forum Analysis By Sharece Michelle Bunn

On Monday, February 27, 2012, Peace Corps Volunteer Sharece Michelle Bunn hosted an English Forum at TNPU. The Forum was held in room 70 on the third floor of the main building.

The forum lasted for five hours.

There were six foreign guests at the TNPU English Forum. All six guests are Peace Corps Volunteers (PCVs) in Ternopilska Oblast. The guests included:

There were three sessions of the English Forum.

1st Session: 9:35-10:55

• Groups 12.1, 14.1, 22.2. 23.1, and 24.1 were invited to the first session.

2nd Session: 11:10-12:30

• Groups 32.1, 33.2, and 34.1 were invited to the second session.

3rd Session: 12:45-2:05

• Groups 42.1, 42.3, 44.1, and 43.2 were invited to the third session.

Each session was eighty minutes long.

As students entered the forum, they were assigned to random groups. The random aspect of the groups was to encourage students to break out of their regular boundaries and work with other students they might not talk to on a regular basis.

PCVs were responsible for monitoring the different groups during the forum Each PCV took a different discussion topic to the five groups and asked questions and led the discussion with the students.

The five topics were:

- Give a man a fish and you'll feed him for a day. Teach a man to fish and you'll feed him for his whole life.
- Gender Roles
- Generalizations (and stereotypes) and
- Education in Ukraine.
